Cement stoep with end walls (one with a seat) and projecting steps. Attached to No. 155.	The erf on which this house stands was deducted from erf H in 1799, when it was acquired by CE Ackermann, who sold it to FJ Hauptfleisch in 1812, who probably built the house.
