SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION:	"Double storey 3-bay house with full-width pediment across front facade with small 2x2 sash and found cast iron vents. Rusticated corner quoins. Modern double storey timber verandah on three sides with pedimented entrance detail. 2x2 flat-arched sashes with internal shutters and 2x2 door with side- and flat-arched fanlight, all with hood mouldings. Fine period garden with cast iron fence and gates."
