SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION:	Long house, single room deep, with Georgianised Cape Dutch facade, and stoep, masonry stairs to attic with buttresses. Single-storey thatched roof, central (both front and rear) and end gables. Barn with mock gable has date 1823 or 1828; middle barn Anglicised with round-headed windows. Upslope, about 200m away is a Victorian structure.
