However, the barn that now forms the main dwelling directly addresses Stellenbosch Kloof Road, and therefore is of landmark significance, particularly as it is located on a rise along the road.
HISTORY:	Was originally named "Aan-den-Weg" it was transferred by Daniel Joubert, the owner of the adjacent farm By-den-Weg, to his son Willem Adolph Joubert in 1812 (Fransen, 2004: 218).
