**HERITAGE ANALYSIS**

SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION:	Cape Dutch farm werf. A linear arrangement of buildings, set along a contour of a sub-valley, and overlooking the Riverklip corridor. The main house is set between linear, barn structures, with some additional sheds added behind. The road passes in front of these buildings, and it edges the river side with low werf walls. An avenue of mature Oaks further adds to the linear elements of the werf.
HISTORY:	Granted to Elbertsz Snr in 1704, transferred to Adriaan Nel in 1739, who likely built the main house c1770. In 1784 Daniel Joubert acquired the farm. He undertook extensions to the site, and built at least one of the barns.
