SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION:	The rise to the south of this landscape shields the R44 and suburban development from view, creating a visual continuum between the Eerste River corridor, the agricultural fields in the foreground, and the foothills and high peaks of the Helderberg Range beyond. This sub-valley also enjoys unique views of Stellenbosch town to the north, with a clear view to the spire of the Dutch Reformed "Moederkerk".
