| SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION: | Like Heather Cottage, this is a Bakeresque Arts & Crafts style single storey structure which, until recently, had a thatched roof. Unfortunately roof sheeting has been applied. The property is densely wooded, and so blends into the rural environment. The house is architecturally modest. It is located on a bend in the road, and so has some landmark significance. Carport structures and other auxiliary structures complete the complex. |
