SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION:	A much older, single-storey and double-pitched vernacular cottage (with roof loft) on a "koffieklip" foundation. The structure, although run down, seems to be authentic and occupies a prominent position on the road into the town.
HISTORY:	Originally a missionary community for emancipated slaves established by Barnabas Shaw following the abolition of slavery at the Cape in 1834. The original lots were rented out to 800 freed slaves.
