SITE & STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION:	A fairly elaborate, single storey Victorian Villa with hipped roof, wrap-around stoep, gable ends with decorative vents, and bay windows. The structure is not highly visible from the street edge, but it appears to retain a high degree of authenticity, and original Victoria fabric and elements. The house appears in the 1938 aerial photography for the area, as a stand-alone structure surrounded by gardens, and with an outbuilding, now on subdivided erf 1644.
