"Two double storey residences with tiled roofs, Monica behind Harmonie. Harmonie has central covered gable with rusticated quoins and projecting porch with arched opening, rustication and plaster mouldings, flanked by a wide verandah with precast cloumns. 6x2 sashes, with shutters on the ground floor. Set back in gardens with boundary wall with ball-topped posts, cast iron railings and gates. Four storey modern extension in Neethling St with steel windows and tiled roof."
