SITE DESCRIPTION

Single-storey dwelling, hipped corrugated iron roof with landmark corner, wrap-around stoep with corrugated-iron roof, plasterwork quoining, original joinery (combination of casement and sash windows), fine plasterwork around doors and windows, two attic windows set into simple, pointed, street-facing gables. The splayed corner has an elaborate gable with scalloped plaster detail, dated 1904.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This structure is characteristic of the early 20th Century residential structures that were constructed in this part of Stellenbosch. It has contextual and architectural significance, and contributes to the streetscape. It may have associations with the forced removals at "Die Vlakte".
