SITE DESCRIPTION

A T-shaped homestead with addition to make an "H". The front gable is dated 1822. There are several outbuildings set behind the house, as well as werf walls that negotiate the slope. The werf contributes to the qualities of the whole, with Uiterwyk, and spatially the two werfs read as a continuum, and present an example of the historical layering of some of the historic werfs in the area.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This werf is historically and spatially part of the Uiterwyk werf, which is a National Monument site. It contributes to the historical and architectural layering of the whole, and additionally has a high degree of aesthetic/contextual significance.

INTERIOR DESCRIPTION

GROUPING WITH OTHER SITES

With Uiterwyk, the adjacent werf which reads spatially with Kastanjeboeg as a continuous whole.

EVIDENCE OF DEMOLITION

SITE HISTORY

A deduction from Uiterwyk.

LANDSCAPE SIGNIFICANCE

Many mature trees that reinforce alignments and spatial edges.

CONTEXTUAL DESIGN

The house is set on an embankment to the north of the Uiterwyk homestead, and creates a parallel edge to the approach of this house. The werf contributes strongly to that of Uiterwyk, and spatially they read as a very fine whole.
