**SITE DESCRIPTION**

An outstanding agricultural valley, with high scenic qualities. The road is one of the older wagon routes to Stellenbosch, and the farm werfs adjacent to it some of the finest in the Stellenbosch area.

The Stellenbosch Kloof Road sub-valley exhibits the unique interplay between wilderness, the rural landscape and the pattern of settlement that is so characteristic of the Cape Winelands. It has very high landscape, historical, aesthetic and scenic significance. Several of the werfs in the valley are of high architectural significance.
