SITE DESCRIPTION

A unique agricultural landscape, with high scenic qualities. The undulating upper reaches of the Bottelary Hills are largely screened from view from the main routes into Stellenbosch, but enjoy extensive panoramic views of the town and the adjacent valleys and mountain landscapes.
