SITE DESCRIPTION

Symmetrical single-storey school building with U-plan and protruding gable ends and central flush gable (lost steep roof and supports).

Except for the intrusive boundary wall of later vintage, this late Victorian school building has aesthetic and architectural significance and is a landmark.
