SITE DESCRIPTION

Farm buildings cluster, extensively altered. Main house symmetrical single-storey Victorian extensively renovated/altered (now with rooms in loft space). Victorian barn with hipped corrugated-iron roof altered to guest rooms. 1980s garage building converted to guest rooms. New Chapel built in valley.
