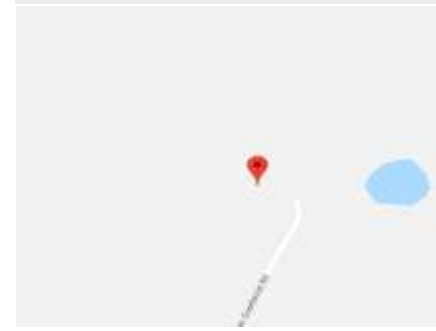

ARCHITECTURAL STYLE

Hybrid Cape Dutch and 1920s-30s.

ARCHITECT/BUILDER

SITE DESCRIPTION

Farmhouse and farm complex including barn and other dwellings. Hybridised early 1800s T-plan homestead with 1920s-30s stoep and symmetrical garden steps. Single-storey homestead originally simple barn plan with central gable. Later U-plan wing additions at the back and 1920s-30s concrete pilastered supported stoep.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

An extremely well landscape-sited farm complex with a hybridised Cape Dutch/Cape Revival and later architecture. The heritage significance comprises aesthetic, architecture and landscape components.
