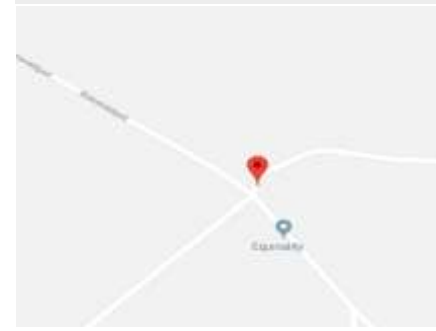

SITE DESCRIPTION

Single-storey asymmetrical pitch-roofed villa with integral stoep with rusticated concrete pillars, some original joinery. Outbuildings (one dated 1950). A 1947 dam marked 'Olofse' behind.

This structure is representative of the mid-20th century building that occurred within the Bottelary. Its scale is sensitive to the area. It has some architectural interest, and contextual significance.
