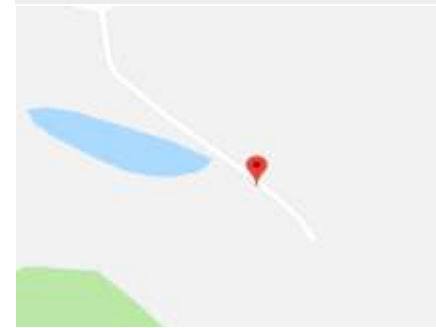

SITE DESCRIPTION

Single-storey symmetrical hipped tiled roof U-plan house with two protruding gable ends and enclosed stoep with rusticated concrete columns and rounded balustrade.
