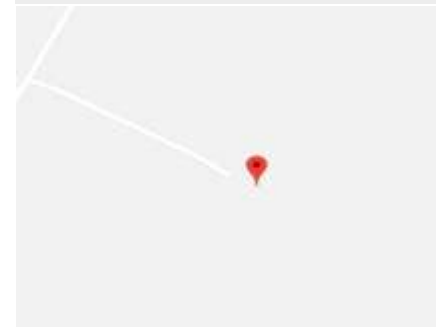

SITE DESCRIPTION

Two dwellings with outbuildings. One modernised and the other a single-storey pyramidal roof and integrated stoep with rusticated concrete pillars; large intrusive addition.

These structures are representative of the mid-20th century building that occurred within the Bottelary. Their scale is sensitive to the area, although there have been some intrusive additions. The site has some architectural interest, and contextual significance.
