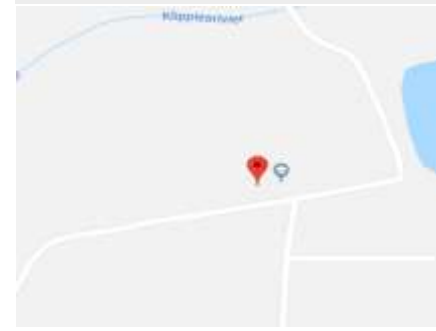

**SITE DESCRIPTION**

H-plan Cape Dutch, one back wing modern, gable extremely elaborate, stoeps modernised. Old outbuilding in line with added gable (1825), restored c.1950.

**STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

A magnificent homestead that retains its local context, including landscaped surrounds and relationship to the river, but has been "institutionalised" internally. This site has considerable historical, architectural, contextual significance. It has associational significance with the development and teaching of agriculture in the area.
