**SITE DESCRIPTION**

A sub-valley within the Eerste River valley that demonstrates the complex relationship between river course, old wagon route, rural landscape and wilderness characterised by the Helderberg peaks beyond. Additional structuring elements such as avenues of trees, gateposts and well-defined farm werf add to the whole.
