SITE DESCRIPTION

Group of structures. Homestead from approx 1850s, single-storey U-plan with protruding gable ends repeatedly altered; stone barn (probably early 20th century) converted to church. Ivy Knowe house late 19th century (Vos, H (2010)).

This is a significant site inhabited by a number of structures variously dating from the 1850's through to the 1900's and located in a splendid scenic and landscape setting.
