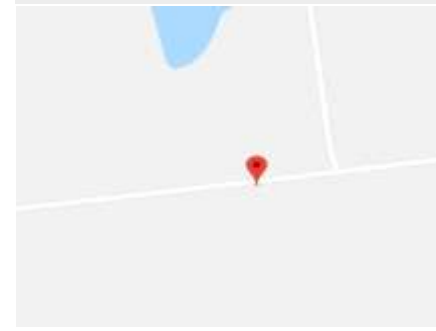

SITE DESCRIPTION

Cape Dutch-style (possibly original) central gable and pilasters engulfed in tall wide barn-like structure under pitched corrugated iron roof; set on steep platform. Located on slope of Klapmuts Kop in an isolated position.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Further investigation is required - the homestead appears to have a Cape Dutch core that is encompassed in an early 20th century steep and roof.
