SITE DESCRIPTION

Single-storey, hipped asbestos-roofed, timber-framed and asbestos-panelled hostels, with metal windows; face-brick chimney stack set centrally in rear wall. Associated with ablution blocks. Diagonally-placed relative to road grid, Now enveloped within informal housing.

This structure is representative of the hostel type buildings that were constructed in Khayamandi. It has high social, community and associational significance. It has strong associations with the history of apartheid in Stellenbosch.
