SITE DESCRIPTION

Single storey, symmetrical Cape Revival style house with central gable, central stoep, salt-glazed brick plinth, cement fibre tiled roof with exposed eave brackets and a Baker-inspired chimney.

This structure is a good example of a Cape Revival style house constructed in this part of Stellenbosch. It retains some original detailing and materials. It has contextual and some architectural significance, and contributes to the streetscape.
