According to the Property and Land Use Inventory (Annexure J) of the Jonkershoek Spatial Development Framework, March 1999, Farm 1022 is 0,0247 ha.

## History

This is part of an 1837 grant to PC van Blommestein which included riverside land till then reserved by the Government. Cadastral boundaries and shapes of this property do not align with the grants in the area which were consolidated, subdivided and re-consolidated in a complex way. By the time this property re-emerged in the 20th century it had a new shape, partly dictated by landscape features.

In 2002 the owner/main shareholder was DJA Zandberg.
